

Solution for problems of Monitor

This section would teach you how to solve the problems that you encounter on your monitor.

When Monitor is not working:

- 1. Check to see if the monitor is switched on.
- 1.1 If it is not on, switch it on again.
- 2. If the <u>monitor</u> has been already switched on or still not on yet, check to see if there is any signal on it.
- 2.1 If there is no signal on the monitor, check your power socket.



Check your power socket



3. If there is signal on the <u>monitor</u>, check to see if its showing orange light instead of green light

Signal of monitor displaying orange light



3.1 If the signal of the <u>monitor</u> is showing orange light, it means that the data cable is loosed. Check the connection of the data cable for both the <u>monitor</u> and the <u>CPU</u>.

Check the data cable connection on the CPU




Check the data cable connection on the monitor





4. If there is signal on the <u>monitor</u>, check to see if it is displaying green light instead of orange light.



4.1 If the signal of the <u>monitor</u> is displaying green light, try to adjust brightness control buttons.





4.12 If adjusting the brightness buttons does not solve the problem, call the IT personnel for <u>monitor</u> replacement.
